

Reference Page

FOR PHARMACY STUDENTS

A list of references prepared by a Pharmacy student could be part of an application for the following:

- scholarship
- internship
- residency
- fellowship
- permanent employment

When references are submitted, you can generally supply a list of 3 to 4 people who can speak on your behalf regarding your quality of work, level of integrity, and/or professionalism.

References can be presented in a number of formats, but the two that are most frequently used are:

1. presented as a separate page to your CV or resume
2. in a separate category on your CV (not resume), listed at the bottom
